I'm sure you are aware that the school had an inspection recently on Wednesday 29th and Thursday 30th January 2025. Our previous inspection was in 2019 when we received an overall judgement that we are a 'good' school.

The new inspection regime no longer awards an overall judgement to schools following an inspection but it grades five different areas of the school as outlined in Ofsted's inspection framework.

We are very pleased to be able to inform you that the school has been judged to be either 'OUTSTANDING' or 'GOOD' in each area. The lead inspector, HMI Karen Kent, and her team of inspectors recognised many of the strengths the school has, which are outlined in his report. In addition, the inspection team shared our evaluation that further strengthening of some curriculum areas, is an area that we want to develop further.
