include antanaclasis,

(a repetition within a sentence)
For example: "All alone, all alone..."

This sentence will...

include antithesis

For example: "Money is the cause of all poverty."

These sentences will...

include epistrophe

(repeating a phrase at the end of sentences)

For example: "...and they blame us. ...and they blame us."

This sentence will...

include irony

For example: "My Chihuahua, Hercules..."

This sentence will...

suggest you are doubtful

For example: "It may be..." "I could have..."

This sentence will...

end with an accusation to the reader

For example: "What are you going to do?"

This sentence will...

end with a repetition of three +ing verbs

For example: "growling, biting and gnashing."

This sentence will...

end in third person plural

For example: "and we wonder why?"

This sentence will...

end with a phrase with two adjectives or more

For example: "..., a final, fateful confirmation."
