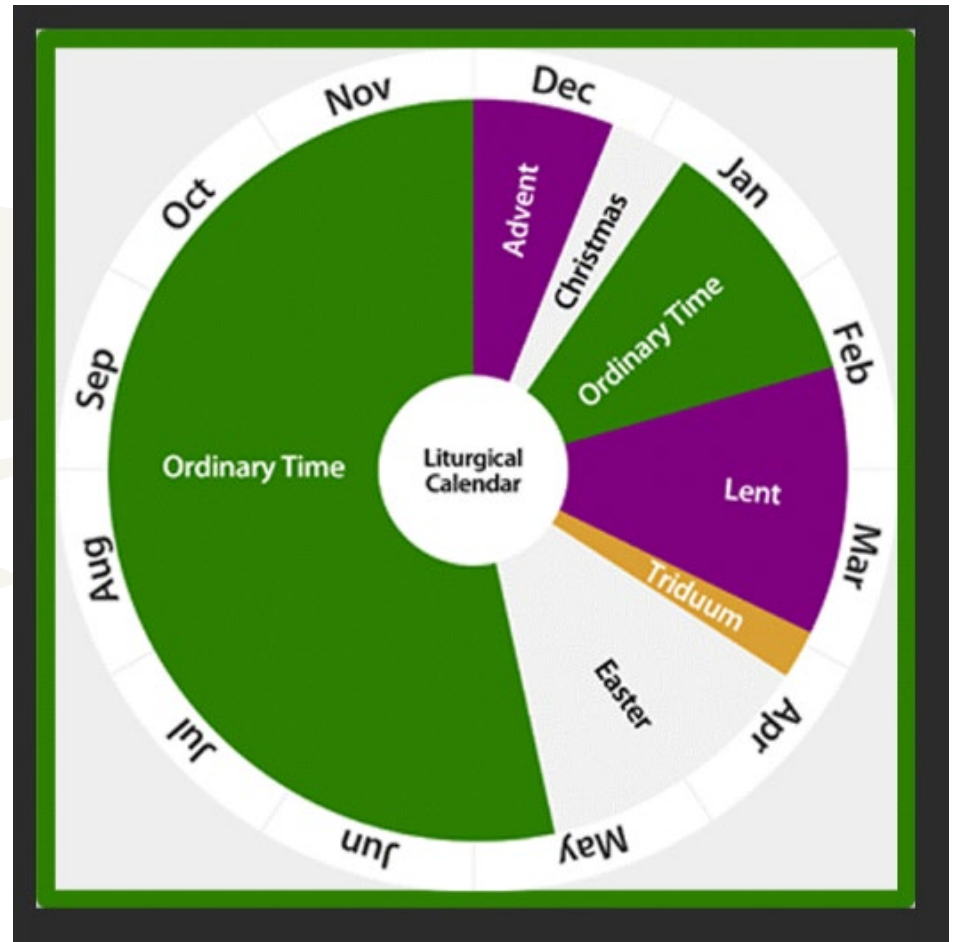

St George's Day

23rd April



Who is St George?

- St George is the Patron Saint of England
- He became our Patron Saint in 1348 (648 years ago)
- Legend has it that St. George slayed the dragon, protecting himself with the sign of the cross



Traditions and History

- It is a tradition to wear red and a red rose on your shirt. The rose is a symbol of St George.
- English soldiers wore a sign on their chest of St George as he is believed to be the protector
- The Georges cross is given as a medal of outstanding bravery to soldiers during war



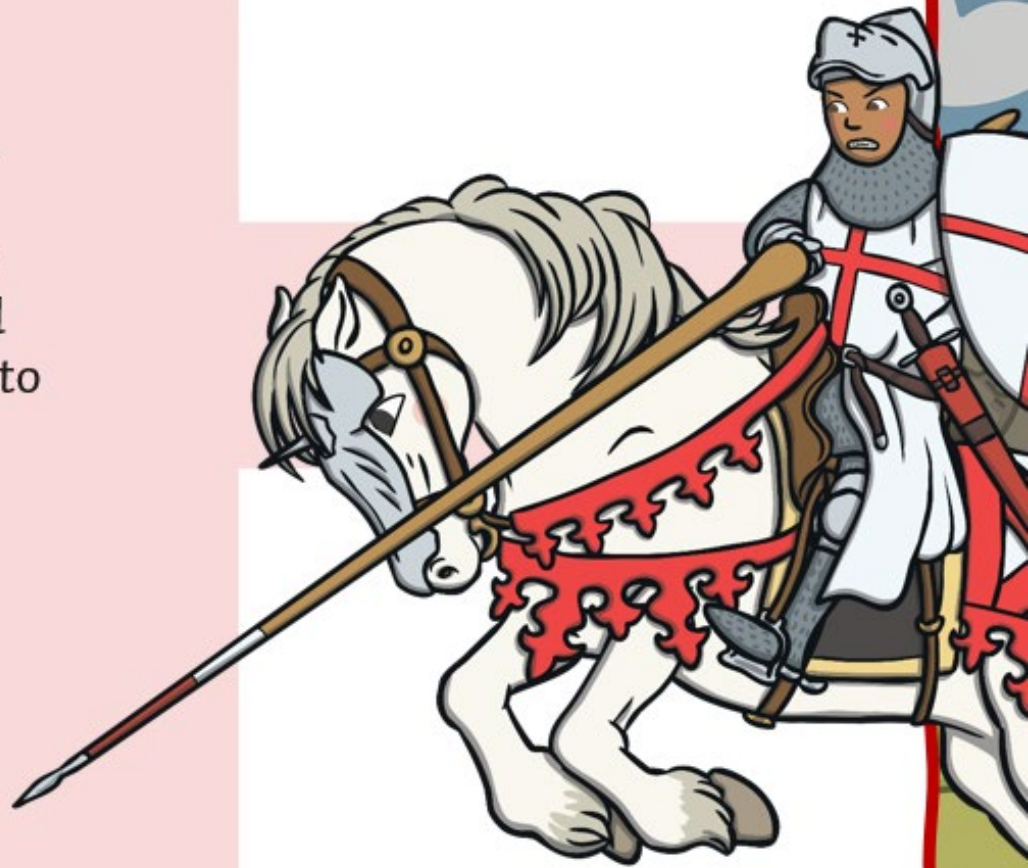
St. George's Cross

- England's flag is called the St. George's Cross. It is a white flag with a red cross on it.
- St. George's flag was adopted by Richard The Lion Heart and brought to England in the 12th century. Soldiers wore it on their tunics to avoid confusion in battle.



St. George's Day

- ❖ Saint George is also the Patron Saint of Scouting.
- ❖ On the Sunday closest to April 23rd, the Scouts and the Guides go on parade to their nearest church.
